- ☐ **Malt and peat** — Can you smell smoke in the rooms? Peated malt makes smoky spirit. SAW _____
- ☐ **Warehouse** — Dunnage is an earth floor with casks three high — cool and slow. Racked pallets are warmer and faster. SAW _____
- ☐ **Cask policy** — Ask what sits in most of their casks, then write the answer. Bourbon, sherry or refill changes the flavour. SAW _____
